Taiwan Completes Normal Tender for 13,000 MT of U.S. Rice

Report Highlights:

On November 10, Taiwan completed a normal tender (GF4-105-131) for 13,000 tons of U.S. medium or short grain brown rice. Taiwan has completed 77 percent of the 2016 U.S. Rice Country Specific Quota (CSQ) tender.

General Information:

November 10 Tender Results:

GF4-105-131 for 13,000 MT of U.S.-origin medium or short grain brown rice for delivery by April 28, 2017: The tender was completed at the first scheduled tender held on November 10.

Six bidders participated in the bid. The tender was successfully awarded to three winning bidders for 2,000 MT, 4,000 MT and 7,000 MT for NT\$18,599/MT (US\$590.72/MT).

As of November 10, Taiwan has completed a 77 percent of the 2016 U.S. rice CSQ tender, including 35,600 MT under simultaneous buy and sell (SBS) tender and 14,150 MT under normal tender scheme. The remaining 14,884 tons is anticipated to be announced by the end of November.
