Report Highlights:

On December 7, 2015, the Administration for Quality, Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine (AQSIQ) released Announcement No.144, 2015 - "The Revision of the Risk Level and the Inspection/Quarantine Supervision Methods for Import and Export of Feed and Feed Additives." The announcement adjusted risk levels and import supervision methods for certain types of animal feed and feed additives. This supersedes AQSIQ Announcement No. 79 of 2009.

Executive Summary:

On December 7, 2015, the Administration for Quality, Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine (AQSIQ) released Announcement No.144, 2015 - "The Revision of the Risk Level and the Inspection/Quarantine Supervision Methods for Import and Export of Feed and Feed Additives." The announcement adjusted risk levels and import supervision methods for certain types of animal feed and feed additives. This supersedes AQSIQ Announcement No. 79 of 2009.

The risk level determines the type of inspection procedure a product will receive upon importation into China. This measure took effect immediately upon its announcement.

This Announcement was issued in accordance with AQSIQ Decree No. 118 (GAIN Report CH9071) on "Supervision and Management Measures for the Inspection and Quarantine of Import and Export Feed and Feed Additives".

AQSIQ Announcement on the Revision of the Risk Level and the Inspection/Quarantine Methods for Import and Export of Feed and Feed Additives

In accordance with the regulations in the Supervision and Management Measures for the Inspection and Quarantine of Import and Export Feed and Feed Additives (AQSIQ Decree No. 118), The Revision of the Risk Level and the Inspection/Quarantine Supervision Methods for Import and Export of Feed and Feed Additives (See Appendix) is now announced. AQSIQ Announcement No. 79 of 2009 shall be repealed simultaneously. AQSIQ will adjust and release the risk levels, inspection and quarantine supervision methods in a timely manner according to the risk analysis results. The list of countries and regions for feed imports and the list of feed products types for import will be announced separately.
