**Report Highlights:**

Indonesia's Agricultural Quarantine Agency issued Ministry of Agriculture Decree No. 756/2015, recognizing California as a fruit fly free area on June 22, 2015.

## General Information:

The Indonesian Agriculture Quarantine Agency (IAQA) issued a decree recognizing California as a fruit fly free area. The decree was signed by the head of IAQA on June 22, 2015 and is one outcome of the assessment and verification visit to the United States in early June 2015. As a result of this decision, California-origin fresh fruit produced in fruit fly-free areas do not require treatment prior to being exported to Indonesia.

Key aspects of the regulation are as follows:

1. The Government of Indonesia recognizes California as a fruit fly free area.
2. The types of fruit flies covered in the decree are:
  - a. *Ceratitis capitata*
  - b. *Anastrepha fraterculus*
  - c. *Anastrepha ludens*
  - d. *Anastrepha obliqua*
  - e. *Anastrepha serpentina*
  - f. *Anastrepha suspensa*
  - g. *Rhagoletis cingulate*
  - h. *Rhagoletis fausta* and
  - i. *Rhagoletis pomonella*
3. The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) shall provide to head of IAQA:
  - a. An annual fruit fly surveillance report
  - b. A report in the event of a detection or fruit fly outbreak.
4. The recognition will be revoked if verification shows that USDA and CDFA are unable to maintain California as a fruit fly free area.
5. Decree 756/2015 replaces IAQA Decree 348/2006 on fruit fly freedom.
