### **India Extends Ban on Imports of Milk and Milk Products from China**

**Report Highlights:**

On January 3, the Government of India (GOI) extended the import prohibition on milk and milk products from China. This ban includes chocolates and chocolate products, candies, confectionary and food preparations with milk or milk solids as an ingredient, originating in China.

**General Information:****Introduction:**

The Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department of Commerce, issued a Gazette notification on January 3, 2011, extending its ongoing prohibition on imports of milk and milk products from China. This extension is valid until December 2011.

Subject: Prohibition on import of milk and milk products from China.

S.O. 9(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5 read along with Section 3(2) of the Foreign Trade (Development and Regulation) Act, 1992, also read along with paragraph 2.1 of Foreign Trade Policy, 2009-14, the Central Government hereby further extends the prohibition on import of milk and milk products including chocolates and chocolate products and candies/confectionery/food preparations with milk or milk solids as an ingredient, from China, imposed vide Notification No. 67(RE-2008)/2004-2009 dated 1st December, 2008 and extended vide Notification No. 49/2009-2014 dated 24th June, 2010, for a period of one year from 24th December, 2010 and until further orders.
