### Indonesia Expands U.S. Plant Products Eligible for Recognition

**Report Highlights:**

On August 16, the Minister of Agriculture signed a decree allowing additional 33 product lines to be eligible for recognition under the protocol for fresh foods of plant origin (FFPO). The recognition enhances market access opportunities for U.S. plant product exports to Indonesia.

**General Information:**

On August 16, 2016, Ministry of Agriculture (MOA) issued decree No. 563/2016 to amend MOA decree No. 704/2015 regarding recognition of U.S. food safety system for fresh foods of plant origin (FFPO). The decree allows additional 33 product lines to be eligible for recognition. Currently, 92 U.S. plant products are listed under the protocol for FFPO. The FFPO protocol is valid until December 10, 2017 and can be renewed.

MOA Regulation No. 4/2015, which was implemented in February, 2015, stipulates import requirements for 103 plant products. Import requirements include certificate of analysis (COA) for chemical (pesticide residue and heavy metal) and microbial tests. The certificates must be issued by laboratories recognized by the government of Indonesia.

Products that originate in countries that have recognition for FFPO are not subjected to these additional import requirements. However, Products that originate in countries which do not have FFPO recognition cannot be imported without COA.
