On August 12, China notified to the WTO The Draft Amendment of National Food Safety Standard- Maximum Levels of Mycotoxins in Foods (GB 2761) as SPS/N/CHN/630. The draft will amend Article 4 to establish the maximum levels of ochratoxin A in wine and coffee. The date for submission of final comments to China is October 11, 2013. The proposed date of entry is to be determined.
