### **Mexico Announces Maximum Sugar Export Quota to the United States**

**Report Highlights:**

The Secretariat of Economy (SE) on August 15, 2018 announced in the *Diario Oficial* (Federal Register) a maximum sugar quota of 750,876.85 metric tons on a raw value basis for export the to the United States during the 2018/19 sugar cycle.

**General Information:**

**Introduction:** This report summarizes an announcement by the Secretariat of Economy (SE) published in Mexico's *Diario Oficial* (Federal Register) on August 15, 2018, containing the maximum sugar export quota to the United States for the 2018/19 sugar cycle.

**Title:** [Notification](#) of the Maximum Sugar Export Quota to the United States from October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019.

**Executive Summary:** In accordance with the Amendment to the Agreement Suspending the Antidumping Duty Investigation published in the Federal Register on July 11, 2017, and in Mexico's *Diario Oficial* on [October 5, 2017](#), Mexico has announced the maximum sugar export quota to the United States for the 2018/19 sugar cycle, calculated in July 2018.

The sugar export quota to the U.S. from October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019, is 750,876.85 metric tons of raw value. This information is based on U.S. needs as published in the July World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates (WASDE) report and the National Committee for the Sustainable Development of Sugar Cane (CONADESUCA) data.
