Report Highlights:

The Government of Ukraine has published an updated list of the products imported into Ukraine, which are subject to official control. The list also specifies the official documents, which must accompany the shipments. This report replaces GAIN report UP1702, submitted in March of 2017.

General Information:

The Government of Ukraine updated the rules for official control of agricultural products imported to Ukraine. The new rules were adopted by Cabinet of Ministers Resolution # 960 ([in Ukrainian](#)). The new rules replaced the old control requirements outlined in [UP1702 GAIN Report](#).

Resolution #960 clearly indicates:

- The type of import certificate required for preliminary documentary control at the point of entry;
- The type of product registration (when applicable) which will be verified at the point of entry;
- The types of control applied to imported food products (specific control measures are outlined in respective sub-laws: Ministry of Agricultural Policy and Food of Ukraine Order #158, Order #159 (Please refer to [UP1830 GAIN Report](#)) and upcoming new Orders);
- Bill of lading and other transport documents (when applicable).

The following official controls will be implemented for imported products by HS codes:

Group 1: Veterinary and Sanitary Control and Certification

The State Service on Safety of Foodstuffs and Consumer Protection (SSUFSCP) requires the original international veterinary certificate issued by the appropriate authorities in the exporting country. Feed additives, premixes, prepared feeds and veterinary medicines are subject to registration and at the time of entry they must be on the official list of approved products.

Group 2: Phytosanitary Control and Certification

SSUFSCP requires:

- Original phytosanitary certificate issued by competent authority on plant quarantine of the exporting country. The certificate should indicate the phytosanitary condition of the commodity (wood packaging material accompanying shipments of commodities, seeds and planting stock is the subject to selective checks based on risk-based phytosanitary control by the SSUFSCP. For more details see page 4);

OR

- Original of phytosanitary certificate issued by competent authority on plant quarantine of the exporting country. The certificate should indicate the phytosanitary condition of the commodity; AND a quality certificate on exported seeds and/or planting stock, or an OECD and an ISTA certificate for seeds and planting stock in cases when specific plant variety is included on the

Registry of Plant Varieties of Ukraine and/or on the List of Plant Varieties of OECD. In the latter case, Ukraine would need to be a member of the OECD Seed Scheme for the specific agricultural plant.

Group 3: Controls and Certification applied to Food, Feed, Byproducts of Animal Origin and Animal Welfare

SSUFSCP requires:

- Original international certificate. This requirement is applicable for commodities mentioned in Order #159 ([in Ukrainian](#)), please refer to appropriate [GAIN Report](#), for explanation in English, as well as Order #158 ([in Ukrainian](#)), which sets inspection requirements for specific contaminants in products imported from specific countries.
Depending on the commodity, the International Certificate could be either a health certificate, a veterinary certificate or any other documents, which certifies to the animal health or safety of food, feed or animal byproducts. Per Ukrainian law, an International Certificate must be issued by the Competent Authority of the exporting country. Please, refer to the most recent FAIRS Narrative report for more information.

Controls vary from country to country based on previous inspection results as well as the number of regulated pests in the exporting country and information about pest identification by the EU Member-States.
