Rice price offers from exporters decreased slightly last week, due to low export demand. Despite these slightly lower prices, buyers are still proffering much lower counterbids.

Paddy prices were up slightly, because the spring crop harvest in the Mekong River Delta is over and because exporters anticipate increased demand from export markets.
